

PRISM Source Vocabulary (PSV)



What is PRISM?

- Combination of XML (for the metadata, re-use rights, and so on) and HTML5 (for the Story content).
- PRISM Source Vocabulary (PSV) is based on the PRISM specification, which is an industry-standard for metadatas, specificly designed for efficient multichannel-publishing-solutions.
- PSV describes who created content, manages and publishes, which medias are targeted, who has the copyrights for republishing and many more.
- More than 1500 companies are in the consortium "Idealliance + Epicomm".









Steps on our way




- Build of a centralized data transformator for all channels

- Import of data from any channel: feed (wire services), print, XML, Word, DAM etc.
- Publishing to any channel, e.g. web, social media, app, print etc.
